## NAME

CURLOPT\_UNRESTRICTED\_AUTH – send credentials to other hosts too

## SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_UNRESTRICTED_AUTH,  
                           long goahead);
```

## DESCRIPTION

A long parameter set to 1 tells libcurl it can continue to send authentication (user+password) credentials when following locations, even when hostname changed. This option is meaningful only when setting *CURLOPT\_FOLLOWLOCATION(3)*.
